As you are aware that the increase in Indian Diaspora, has resulted in situations when children are alleged to be abducted by their own parents to India or to a foreign country and law enforcement agencies or even courts have limitations to address the issue.

Faced with this situation, the issue of accession to the Hague Convention on the Civil Aspects of International Child Abduction, 1980 has been under consideration of the Government of India. The Ministry of Women and Child Development has drafted legislation "The International Child Removal and Retention Bill, 2016", in order to have an enabling legislation in India to give effect to the provisions of Hague Convention on the Civil Aspects. This draft legislation aims to facilitate prompt return of any child under 16 who has been "wrongfully removed to or retained in other state which is not his/her habitual residence." The draft law mandates setting up of a central authority, to be headed by a joint secretary level officer, where an aggrieved parent can approach for the return of a child. The authority would have the power to decide all such cases.

The National Commission for Women, which has been nominated as coordinating agency to deal with various issues arising out of NRI/Overseas marriages, is concerned about the various implications of the draft Bill. Therefore National Commission for Women is holding a Consultation to discuss the draft bill with various stakeholders on 30th August 2016 at Conference Hall No. 2, India International Centre, New Delhi at 2.30 pm. Concept Note of the Consultation is enclosed.

The release International Indians and the Law was followed by a panel discussion on 'Inter country Parental Child Removal Issues'.

The focus of the talk was on the quagmires of international law that dealt with processes of identity giving to children caught in international disputes. Cases of inter-country adoption, custody battles between couples going through a divorce and residents of different countries and recent cases of transnational surrogacy wherein newborns have been rendered stateless due to the illegal status of surrogacy in their parents' country of residence were some of the focus areas for the panelists.

The Hague Convention and Treaty on International Adoption that governs inter-country adoption processes

and is now seeking to regulate disputes and processes of citizenship in case of transnational surrogacy, was discussed with reference to specific country laws. The primary focus of the debate revolved around the Indian juridical importance given to the practice of 'best interests of the child' as opposed to the Hague Convention's support for identifying citizenship of the child at the place where it is residing. This means that inter-country adoption cases for countries like India that are donor nations become potentially thorny issues, especially since a ruling (Laxmi Kant Pandey vs Union of India) supported domestic adoptions for Indian children.

The matching of international and national laws on child rights and identity giving to children clashes in cases of divorce custody disputes and transnational surrogacy, especially since there is an increasing movement of children across borders. This may include trafficking and other forms of forced movement which for many of the panelists was problematic when seen in relation to the arguments put forth in favour of the 'best interests of the child'. Supporters of the latter argument suggested the issues of acclimatization and being habituated in a particular cultural locale as reasons why the child should be retained in a particular set of relations and circumstances. Within such opposing arguments, rights of the mother and father to custody of the child were debates, as were rights of adoptive parents vis-à-vis biological parents.
